



AGPN 2010 Board Election outcome

The results of the AGPN 2010 Board Election have now been declared by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC).

On Thursday 9 September 2010 at 9.00 am the AEC conducted a count of ballots at their office for the six vacant positions on the AGPN Board of Directors.

Scrutineers present were:

David Butt – CEO AGPN
Carolyn Campbell-Wood – CFO AGPN
Margarete Conroy – Company Secretary AGPN

99 ballot papers were received of which four were rejected as incomplete or incorrectly completed. One was considered an informal vote. Therefore 94 valid ballot papers were counted (a total of 457 votes).

The results of the ballot are as follows:

1st and 2nd highest votes – elected until end of 2013 AGM
Tony Lembke (NSW) and Karen Stringer (NT)

3rd and 4th highest votes – elected until end of 2012 AGM
Emil Djakic (TAS) and Michael Nolan (VIC)

5th and 6th highest votes – elected until end of 2011 AGM
Rod Pearce (SA) and Arn Sprogis (NSW)

The rule on there being no more than two Elected Directors from any one State did not need to be applied.
